FCI allround sudac

Još od djetinjstva Monique Van Brempt je voljela i bila okružena psima : belgijskim ovčarima, jazavčarima, njemačkim ovčarima i dugodlakim kolijima.

Monique je počela ozbiljno uzgajati i suditi škotske terijere 1973.godine. Malo nakon toga, dandie dinmont terijeri priključili su se obitelji.

Pod prefiksom "Limecourt" Monique je uzgojila velik broj vrhunskih pasa koji su poslije ponijeli titule europskih, nacionalnih, internacionalnih i svjetskih šampiona, pobjednike grupa i nekoliko prestižnih BIS-ova.

Sudačku karijeru je započela 1980.godine i od tada je sudila diljem svijeta, u 34 zemlje na 6 različitih kontinenata. Osim suđenja na raznim nacionalnim i internacionalnim izložbama, imala je čast suditi i na svjetski najprestižnijim izložbama poput Svjetskih izložbi 1995, 1996, 1998, 2000, 2001, 2002, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010 i 2011.godine. sudila je i na mnogim Europskim izložbama i u svim europskim i istočnoeuropskim zemljama. Također je bila jedan od sudaca Champion of Champions natjecanja u Engleskoj, Finskoj, Švedskoj, Portugalu, Irskoj, Belgiji, Švicarskoj i Rusiji. Redovan je sudac već 3 najveće Eurasia izložbe, 12 izložbi u Sankt Petersburgu i nekoliko drugih izložbi u Rusiji. Također često sudi i u skandinavskim zemljama. Na drugoj strani svijeta sudila je u Americi – Malibu, australski Melbourne Royal, Brisbane, Sydney te se rado sjeća i svojih prekrasnih iskustava iz Tajlanda, Japana, Koreje, Kine, Mongolije, Kolumbije, Čilea, Kenije, Vijetnama, Puerto Rica, Singapura, Indije itd.

Kao aktivni član mnogih klubova, Monique je bila predsjednik "Kraljevskog belgijskog terijer kluba" od 1987.godine, u kojem je od 1983.vršila dužnost vice-predsjednika. Među njenim zadacima voditelja izložbe mnogih belgijskih izložbi terijera, Monique je bila zadužena i za redakciju klupskog magazina. 1998.godine postala je predsjednik "Interre"- međunarodne asocijacije FCI-a svih terijerskih klubova. U njoj je Monique zadužena za organiziranje simpozija za terijere te razne druge aktivnosti. Do sad asocijacija broji 21 zemlju članicu.

Strast i odanost psima drži ju veoma zaposlenom, što se može objasniti i njenom izjavom : "volim pse"!

Since her childhood Monique Van Brempt fancied and was surrounded by her loving dogs: Belgian Shepherds, Dachshunds, German Shepherds and Rough Collies.

Monique started seriously breeding and showing the Scottish Terriers in 1973. Later the Dandie Dinmont Terriers joined the doggie-family.

Under her kennel name "Limecourt" Monique registered and bred many high quality offsprings who were later on entitled with European, National, International and World Champion titles and also winning the groups and several prestigious Best in Shows.

Mrs. Monique Van Brempt's judging career started in 1980 and since then she is judging worldwide and until now her judging appointments took her to 34 different countries on the 6 continents.

Besides being asked frequently for all breeds judging appointments at the National and International dog shows all over the world, she had a privilege of judging some of the world's most prestigious shows like at World Dog shows in 1995, 1996, 1998, 2000, 2001, 2002, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011! She judged at many European Shows and all the European and East European countries. She also judged at the Champion of Champions contests in England, Finland, Sweden, Portugal, Ireland, Belgium, Switzerland and Russia. She is regularly invited from the Russian Kennel Club judging 3 times the biggest Eurasia show, 12 shows in Saint Petersburg and several other shows in Russia.

Many of her appointments are taking her often to the 4 Scandinavian countries. Talking about the other end of the globe, she enjoyed judging in the USA - Malibu, the Australian Melbourne Royal show, also in Brisbane and Sydney and had beautiful dog-experiences in Thailand, Japan, Korea, China, Mongolia, Columbia, Chile, Kenya, Vietnam, Puerto Rico, Singapore, India etc.

As an active member in many Clubs Monique was the Chairman of "THE ROYAL BELGIAN TERRIER CLUB" since 1987, where she was Vice-Chairman since 1983.

Among her tasks as Show-manager of many successful Belgian Top Terrier shows Monique was also in charge of the redaction of the Club's Magazine.

In 1998 Monique became President of the "INTERRA - The International Association of All Terrier-Clubs (FCI)".

In this association Monique organizes symposiums about the Terrier breeds and she is involved with various activities.

So far 21 countries are members of "The International Association of All Terrier-Clubs (FCI)".
