Moja uzgajateljica nosi ime v.h.Lamslag. Lamslag nema neko posebno značenje, to je naziv stare nizozemske kuće iz 18-tog stoljeća.

Prvog psa sam dobio 1965/1966 kad sam bio 15-16 godina star, to je bila standard jazavčarka duge dlake. 1968. godine sam nabavio svog drugog psa pasmine Kavalir King Charles Španijel. Još uvijek uzgajam i izlažem Kavalire te također posjedujem par Čivava. Uzgajao sam Jazavčare svih varijeteta no od njih sam odustao kasnih 80-tih. U sedamdesetima sam također uzgajao Afganistanske hrtove i dobio svoj prvi BIS na maloj izložbi. Nikad neću zaboraviti svog prvog jazavčara imenom Juno no on nije bio uspješan izložbeni pas. Prvi svjetski šampion je bio naš Kratkodlaki jazavčar Huibje v.h.Lamslag.

Moj Afganistanski hrt Khozar v.h.Lamslag još živi u mom srcu i sjećanju. Što se tiče Kavalira veoma mi je teško izdvojiti nekoga posebno. Constantijn i Donavan v.h.Lamslag su bili moji prvi poznati psi no moram spomenuti i top KKCS psa u Americi, Corneel v.h.Lamslag u vlasništvu Janet York.

Prva pasmina za koju sam postao sudac bili su Kavaliri, 1974.godine. Nekoliko godina poslije postao sam sudac i za Jazavčare.

Međunarodni FCI sudac sam za:
Sve pasmine FCI grupe IV, VI, VIII i IX
Iz Grupe V : Meksički i Peruvijanski Golokoži pas.

Sudio sam u skoro svim europskim zemljama te u Americi.

Ponekad se čini kako je taj pseći svijet sve više i više nastrojen natjecateljski no ne smijemo zaboraviti kako smo svi počeli radi strasti prema našim psima. Trebali bi se opustiti i voljeti naše pse ni zbog ijednog drugog razloga osim toga što su naši psi. Pseći svijet se ne bi trebao vrtiti oko moći pobjeđivanja.

Zadnje ali ne najmanje važno: oženjen sam od 1974.godine za svoju ženu Gerdu.

My kennel name is v.h. LAMSLAG.

Lamslag doesn't mean anything in itself. It is the very old Dutch name of our late-18th Century house.

I got my first dog in 1965 or 1966, when I was 15-16 years old. She was a B/T Standard Dachshund -Long-hair.

My second dog was a Cavalier King Charles Spaniel in 1968.

Still breed and show Cavaliers, also enjoy having a few Chihuahuas.

I have bred all Dachshund varieties, but gave up this in the late 1980s.

I also bred Afghans and won my first BIS at a small show with my home-bred Afghan in the mid-'70s.

We continue to breed Cavaliers on a small scale.

I will never forget my first Dachshund, Juno, but she was not a successful show dog.

The first World Champion was our smooth-hair Dachshund, Huibje v.h. Lamslag.

My Afghan, Khozar v.h. Lamslag, still lives in my heart and memory.

Among the Cavaliers, it is more difficult, since there have been so many. Constantijn & Donavan v.h.Lamslag were my first really famous ones, but I should also mention my first top winning Cavalier in the USA, Corneel v.h. Lamslag, owned by Janet York.

The first breed I qualified to judge was Cavaliers.

The authorisation was issued by the Dutch Kennel Club in 1974.

Dachshunds followed a couple of years later.

Int. FCI-judge:

All breeds in group 4, 6, 8 & 9.

Group 5: Mexican and Peruvian Hairless.

I judged in almost all the European countries and the USA.

Sometimes it seems that the dog world is becoming more and more competitive, but we must not forget that we all started out as a result of our passion for dogs. We should try to relax and love our dogs for no reason other than that they are our dogs.

The dogworld should not be about power or winning.
