



JASNA KOVAČEVIĆ

Međunarodni sudac FCI grupe 1 za britanske ovčarske pasmine, kinologiju je nanjušila davne 1972. u Umagu, na izložbi na koju ju je jedna engleska poenterka dovela na uzici. 1980. naizgled slučajna susret s grupom škotskih ovčara u jednom parku u Zagrebu odredio je daljnji smjer događaja. Tijekom osamdesetih događa se potpuna predanost pasmini: proučavanje standarda, rodovnika, povijesti pasmine, uzgoja i značajnih uzgajivača. Uz to, dva legla i puno posjeta izložbama doveli su do želje da se započne ozbiljan vlastiti uzgoj pa je 1990. registrirana uzgajivačnica Triad. Slijedilo je petnaestak godina intenzivnog uzgoja i izlaganja, pet šampiona uzgojenih u Triadu i četiri uvezena psa koji su dovedeni do šampionske titule u vlasništvu Triada. Zbog novih okolnosti, godine 2008. osnovana je nova uzgajivačnica Roughian u kojoj se nastavlja uzgoj iz Triada.

Odluka da se 1997. pristupi sudačkom ispitu, nekako je izrasla sama od sebe kao rezultat svih tih aktivnosti. Suđenje, pretežito na specijalnim izložbama za britanske ovčarske pasmine ili škotske ovčare, događalo se u Hrvatskoj, ali i po svijetu: Slovenija, Njemačka, Finska, Australija i Danska, ove godine.

Jasna Kovačević je također član osnivačke grupe Udruge za školovanje pasa vodiča i mobilitet slijepih, čija je dopredsjednica bila 12 godina. Osnivač je programa za socijalizaciju i uzgoj štenaca u Udruzi.

An international FCI judge since 1997 approved to award CAC and CACIB in British sheepdog breeds, entered the show dog world in 1972, at the CACIB dog show in Umag, handled by an English pointer bitch. In 1980, an accidental meeting with a bunch of Rough Collies in a park in Zagreb designated the direction ahead. During the eighties, a complete dedication to research about rough collies included studies of the breed standard, pedigrees and the history of Rough Collies and their respected breeders. Furthermore, two litters and frequent visits to dog shows inevitably led to the idea of starting an own, serious breeding programme. In 1991, kennel Triad was founded on Steadlyn bloodline. During more than fifteen years of focused breeding and showing, five champions were born at Triad, and three Steadlyn /Steadwyn imports were handled to their champion titles. In 2008, due to different circumstances, a new kennel - Roughian Collies - was established on Triad breeding stock and continued the Triad vision. In 1997, the decision about becoming a dog show judge grew up on its own as the result of all those dog related activities. Invitations to judge at dog shows (mostly all British Sheepdog breeds, or Collie shows) have come from Croatia, Slovenia, Germany, Finland, Australia and Denmark, this year).

Jasna Kovačević was also a member of the foundation group that established Croatian Guide Dog and Mobility Association. She was its vice-president for 12 years and established puppy walking and breeding programme of the Association.
