Jedan period sam držao tečajeve sucima pripravnicima.

Od 2001. godine pišem te radim kao stručni konzultant na „The Dog Great Encyclopedia“ (5 svezaka), izdane od najveće talijanske izdavačke kuće DeAgostini. 2004. godine sam također pisao članke za „Quattro Zampe“ (4 noge), a od 2006.godine pišem za „Giornale di Sicilia“ (sicilijanske dnevne novine).

I was breeder of English Cocker Spaniel, I was owner of more than one Great Danes and now I breed only few top level Italian Braccos; the most famous of his Italian Braccos is Axel del Monte Alago, BIS in FCI World Dog Show 2006 in Poland and BIS in Eukanuba World Challenge 2009 in Los Angeles. My Kennel name is “del Tavuliddaro”.

I became judge when I was only 25 years old.

I was member and Vice-President, about for ten years, of Central Board of Italian Breed Club for Great Danes.

I was member, about for more than ten years, of the Central Board of Italian Breed Club of Spaniels, where, I was Vice-President until few years ago. I judged in Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Bielorrussia, Brasil, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Cyprus, Denmark, Finland, Greece, Great Britain, India, Ireland, Israel, Latvia, Lithuania, Norway, New Zealand, Holland, Hungary, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russia, San Marino Republic, Serbia, Slovenia, Switzerland, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Turkey, Ukraina, Uruguay and Venezuela. I was also teacher in some courses of cynotechnology for aspiring judges.

Starting from 2001 I'm writer and scientific consultant of “The Dog Great Encyclopaedia” (five volumes) of the biggest Italian publishing house DeAgostini, during 2004 I had been writer for “Quattro Zampe” (Four Legs) and from 2006 also writer for “Giornale di Sicilia” (Sicilia's Newspaper).
