Osim sudačkih aktivnosti član sam i nekoliko nacionalnih uzgojnih komisija Zveze, za terijere, za hrtove, dobermane, šnaucere i pinčere te također član Nacionalnog povjerenstva za Junior Handling.

Član sam Uprave slovenskog Terijer kluba, te sudjelujem u izložbenom odboru Međunarodne izložbe pasa u Mariboru. Slovenski Klub za Hrtove je također dio mojih interesa.

Sudio sam na velikom broju izložbi po cijeloj Europi, kao i u Australiji, Kanadi, Aziji i Africi.

Osim slovenskog jezika služim se engleskom, francuskim, njemačkim, srpsko-hrvatskim i ruskim jezikom. Imam jednu kćer (21) i jednog sina (8).

I am the architect (M.Sc.) ruling city planning office in Maribor and my own architectural practise. I have been in dog world since my childhood and for last 18 years I am active in Slovenian Kennel Club.

I started with Irish soft-coated wheaten terrier and promoted the breed in Slovenia. Now I enjoy being with an Azawakh.

My judging career started 1993 with terriers. I continued getting the international judging licenses for other breeds, so far I am licensed to judge all breeds of complete: 1st, 2 nd, 3 rd, 4th, 7th, 8 th, 9 th and 10 th FCI groups as well as for junior handling.

Besides the judging activities I am the member of few National Stud Commissions by Slovenian Kennel Club: for terriers, for sighthounds, for dobermanns and for schnauzers and pinchers and also the member of National Commission for Junior handling.

I am board member of Slovenian Terrier Club and participate in the show committee of Maribor International dog show. Slovenian Sighthound club is also part of my interests.

I am judging very often in dog shows all-round Europe, as well as in Australia, Canada Asia and Africa.

Besides Slovenian, I judge in English, French, German, Serbo-Croatian and Russian language. I have one daughter (21) and one son (8).
