



DRAŽEN MATIČIĆ

Dražen (Zvonko) Matičić, magistar inženjer zootehnike (mag.ing.agr.), rođen 02.01.1957.godine u Karlovcu sa mjestom stanovanja u Karlovcu. Od 1986.godine u Šumskom gospodarstvu Karlovac radi na poslovima lovstva, a tako i danas kao Stručni suradnik za lovstvo u Stručnim službama Uprave šuma podružnice Karlovac (HŠ d.o.o. Zagreb).

Bio je član Kinološkog športskog kluba Karlovac 1976./77./78. godine, a 1979. godine postaje član Kinološkog društva „Duga Resa“ iz Duga Rese gdje je i danas član Izvršnog odbora društva. U Hrvatskom kinološkom savezu u Zagrebu obnašao je funkciju predsjednika Povjerenstva za kadrove i priredbe, predsjednika Povjerenstva za autohtone pasmine pasa i član Povjerenstva za lovne pasmine pasa.

Vlasnik je uzgajačnice pasa „ČIČAK“-HR-FCI-2399 (registrirana 1985.god.), uglavnom poznate po uzgoju istarskih kratkodlakih goniča. Od 1994. do 2003.godine bio je uključen u akciju Hrvatskog kinološkog saveza; Autohtone pasmine pasa-Hrvatska nacionalna baština, gdje je u svojstvu uzgajača i vlasnika pasmine istarski kratkodlaki gonič iste prezentirao na tada svim europskim i svjetskim izložbama pasa te osvajao titule šampiona Europe i Svijeta (Belgija, Mađarska, Puerto Rico-USA, Danska, Italija, Austrija, Švicarska i dr.). Posjeduje pse istarskog kratkodlakog goniča i ariješkog goniča.

Pisao je stručne članke sa tematikom lova i lovne kinologije, a isti su objavljeni u glasilima HKS-a „Moj pas“, HLS-a „Lovački vjesnik“, časopisu „Hrvatskih šuma“ HŠ d.o.o. Zagreb i dr.

Međunarodni je kinološki sudac za oblik slijedećih pasmina pasa/FCI grupa: FCI 3 (Njemački lovni terijer te Foksterijer Kratke i Oštre dlake), te svih

pasmina iz FCI grupa IV, VI i VIII. Također je sudac za rad goniča i krvosljednika.

Član je lovačkog društva „GAJ“ Zvečaj (lovački savez Karlovačke županije, HLS) od 1979.godine. U istome društvu obnašao je mnoge dužnosti/funkcije kao i sada već treći mandat predsjednika društva.

Dugogodišnji je ovlaštenu vještak Ministarstva kulture za procjenu šteta od strogo zaštićenih vrsta životinja.

Odlikovao je odličjima Hrvatskog lovačkog saveza I, II i III- reda, Odlikovao je odličjem Kinološke zveze Slovenije III-ređa, Odlikovao je Zlatnim odlikovanjem HKS-a,

Primio je Zlatnu medalju KD „Duga Resa“ iz Duga Rese, Gradsko vijeće grada Karlovca dodijelilo mu je Nagradu grada Karlovca za promicanje autohtonih pasmina pasa-Hrvatske nacionalne baštine,

Odlikovao je odličjima iz Domovinskog rata i drugim.

Od 1991.godine neprekidno do oslobođenja Domovine bio je u postrojbama ZNG/HV/ VP-e. Časnik je i ratni zapovjednik.

Aktivni je član nekoliko Udruga proisteklih iz Domovinskog rata te ostalih građanskih sportskih i društvenih Udruga.

Oženjen je i roditelj triju studentica na fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu.

Do sada nije bio kazneno gonjen i kažnjavao.

Dražen (Zvonko) Matičić, mag.ing.agr. was born on 2nd of January 1957 in Karlovac and is still living in Karlovac. Since 1986 he is employed in The Economy of Forest of Karlovac where he is involved with jobs related to hunting. He is an Expertise associate for hunting in Technical division of Forest Administration, in city of Karlovac.

He was a member of Sports Kennel Club Karlovac from 1976 till 1978, then in 1979 he became a member of Kennel Club “Duga Resa” where he is still a member of Executive Committee.

In Croatian Kennel Club he was a president of Commission for events and judges and of Commission for native dog breeds as well as a member of Commission for work and breeding of hunting dogs. He is an owner of a kennel registered in 1985 “Čičak”, mostly known for breeding of Istrian Shorthaired Hounds. In the period of 1994 -2003 he was involved with an action of Croatian Kennel Club: Native dog breeds – Croatian national heritage, where he was as a breeder and owner of the Istrian Shorthaired Hounds, presenting them on world and european shows winning multiple titles (Belgium, Hungary, Puerto Rico, USA, Denmark, Italy, Austria, Switzerland etc.) He owns Istrian Shorthaired Hound and Ariege Hound.

He wrote expertise articles hunting cynology related which were published in official magazines of Croatian Kennel Club “My Dog”, of Croatian hunting Association “Hunting news” and magazine of Croatian Forests.

He is International FCI judge for: German Hunting terrier and Foxterrier wire/smooth from FCI Group III, all breeds from FCI Groups IV, VI, VIII and for work of Scenthounds and Leash hounds.

He is member of Hunting club „GAJ“ Zvečaj (hunting club of Karlovac county) since 1979. In that same club he was on large number of positions. Nowadays he is on his 3rd mandate as a president of it.

He is a longtime expert authorized by the Ministry of Culture to assess damage caused by strictly protected animal species.

Honors and awards:

- He was awarded with medals of Croatian Hunting Association, I, II and III rd order
- He was awarded with Medal of Kennel club of Slovenia of 3rd order
- He was awarded with the Golden medal of Croatian Kennel Club
- He received Gold Medal of KC “Duga Resa” in Duga Resa,
- The city council of the city of Karlovac has given him a prize for promoting native dog breeds
- He was awarded with medals from the War and others.

Since 1991 until liberation of our country he was in units of the National Guard / Army / VP's. He is an officer and war commander.

He is an active member of several associations derived from war and other civic and community sports association.

He is married and a father of three student girls at the Zagreb University.

Until now he hasn't been nor prosecuted nor punished.
