Bila sam okružena psima od malih nogu, nisu to bili čistokrvni psi već križanci, no oni su mi predstavljali veliku podršku i naučili me odgovornosti. Moj prvi tibetski terijer dolazi 1999, no ljubav prema toj pasmini je postojala godinama ranije. Vrlo brzo sam registrirala Lhun-Po uzgajalicu i polako, ali sigurno krenula s uzgojem.

U 10-tak godina nisam imala puno legala, ali se među njima nalazi veliki broj prvaka diljem svijeta, uključivši i engleskog prvaka na što sam iznimno ponosna. Iako su tibetski terijeri na prvom mjestu mojih interesa, veliki sam ljubitelj svih tibetskih pasmina, te sam u svrhu boljeg upoznavanja njihovog značaja i podrijetla, te uz kvalitetnu pratnju, 2007. oputovala na Tibet kako bih se upoznala s izvornim primjercima tibetskih pasmina kojih još uvijek ima u njihovoj matičnoj zemlji. Jedan sam od osnivača Kluba tibetskih pasmina gdje obnašam funkciju predsjednice od 2006.

Sudac sam za cijelu IX. FCI grupu, te za Tibetske Mastife. Po struci sam prof. filozofije, logike i religijske kulture, no psi su definitivno zauzeli velik dio mog života i života moje obitelji.

I was surrounded by dogs from an early age, they were not purebred dogs but have represented great support and taught me responsibility. My first Tibetan Terrier came in 1999, but the love for that breed has existed for years. Shortly after that, I registered my kennel under the name of "Lhun-Po" under which I am still breeding.

In the past 10 years I haven't had a large number of litters, however, there is a great number of champions around the world, including the English championship title on which I'm extremely proud. Although Tibetan Terriers are on the first place of my interests, I'm a huge fan of all Tibetan breeds. In order to better inform of their significance and origin, with a quality companion, I travelled to Tibet in 2007. I got familiar with the original specimens of Tibetan breeds which are still living in their home country. I am one of the founders of the Club of Tibetan breeds where I am on the position of President since 2006.

I got my judging license for the whole FCI Group IX and Tibetan Mastiffs from the FCI Group II. Professionally I am a professor of philosophy, logic and religious culture, but dogs have definitely taken a big part of mine and my family's life.
