



ANDREW BRACE

Prvi pas s pedigreeom u vlasništvu Andrew Bracea bio je Bokser kojeg je imao u dobi od 11 godina. Nakon slabijeg uspjeha u Bokserima prebacio je svoju pozornost na Patuljaste pasmine, odnosno, Pekinezere u kojoj je imao i svog prvog šampiona.

Njegova uzgajalica TRAGBAND je postala više povezana sa Biglovima i Afganistanskim hrtovima. Njegova ženka Bigla Ch. Too Darn Hot For Tragband drži record po broju dobivenih CC-ova u pasmini.

Andrew je prvi put dodjeljivao CC u Pekinezerima 1977.godine, sudio cijelu Toy grupu 1981. godine i postao je najmlađi All-Round sudac u UK 1988. godine.

Autor je mnogih knjiga uključujući i cijenjeni "Vodič za ocjenjivanje pasa" i redovni je dopisnik psećih novina poput Dog world i Your dog u UK, Dog news u SAD-u, Dog News Australija, Hundsport u Švedskoj i Magazina za hrtove. Sa Anne Rogers Clark je napravio Internacionalnu enciklopediju pasa.

Andrew je urednik konzultant Dog Worlda, vodećeg tjednog psećeg magazina.

Andrew Brace je od strane Engleskog saveza odobren za dodjeljivanje CC-ova u više od 90 pasmina te sudi Grupe i BIS-ove.

Sudio je mnogo u inozemstvu u sljedećim zemljama: SAD, Kanada, Brazil, Argentina, Čile, Urugvaj, Kolumbija, Barbados, Trinidad, Portoriko, Zambija, Južna Afrika, Kenija, Australija, Novi Zeland, Kina, Hong Kong, Malezija, Japan, Koreja, Singapur, Tajland, Italija, Francuska, Nizozemska, Njemačka, Poljska, Belgija, Grčka, Malta, Španjolska, Portugal, Gibraltar, Norveška, Švedska, Danska, Finska, Island, Hrvatska, Slovačka, Slovenija, Rumunjska, Mađarska i Irska.

Redovno drži seminare u UK i u inozemstvu o raznim temama povezanih sa psima i komentira o sportu u raznim medijima.

ANDREW BRACE's first pedigree dog was the Boxer he owned at the age of eleven.

After modest success with Boxers, he turned his attentions to the Toy breeds, notably Pekingese in which breed he made up his first Champion.

Subsequently his TRAGBAND affix became more associated with Beagles and Afghan Hounds, his Beagle bitch CH. TOO DARN HOT FOR TRAGBAND holding the all-time record for CCs won in the breed.

Andrew first awarded Challenge Certificates in Pekingese in 1977, judged his first Toy Group at Championship level in 1981 and became the UK's youngest All Breeds Championship Best in Show judge in 1988.

He is the author of several specialist books including the much acclaimed THE ESSENTIAL GUIDE TO JUDGING DOGS and is a regular contributor to several canine periodicals including DOG WORLD and YOUR DOG in the UK, DOG NEWS in the USA, DOG NEWS AUSTRALIA, HUNDSPORT in Sweden and THE SIGHTHOUND MAGAZINE. With Anne Rogers Clark he co-edited THE INTERNATIONAL ENCYCLOPAEDIA OF DOGS.

Andrew is Consultant Editor of DOG WORLD, the UK's leading weekly specialist newspaper.

Andrew Brace has been approved by the Kennel Club to award CCs in more than 90 breeds across all the groups, and judges all Groups as well as Best in Show.

He has judged extensively overseas, officiating in the USA, Canada, Brazil, Argentina, Chile, Uruguay, Colombia, Barbados, Trinidad, Puerto Rico, Zambia, South Africa, Kenya, Australia, New Zealand, China, Hong Kong, Malaysia, Japan, Korea, Singapore, Thailand, Italy, France, Holland, Germany, Poland, Belgium, Greece, Malta, Spain, Portugal, Gibraltar, Norway, Sweden, Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Croatia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Romania, Hungary and Ireland.

Andrew regularly gives seminars at home and overseas on a variety of canine topics and commentates on the sport regularly in a variety of media.
